

TUITION & FEES

TUITION RATES AND FEES:

All classes require a year-long (Sept-April) commitment (27 weeks)

Yearly Tuition:

\$371 for Twinkle Toes (Preschool)

\$310 for 45-minute class (Elementary/Youth/Adult)

\$385 for 60-minute class (Elementary/Youth/Adult)

\$385 for Pointe I (1 hr, once a week)

\$537 for Advanced Pointe II and III (45 minutes, twice a week)

Preschool Twinkle Toes Lunch Bunch:

- \$190 additional (yearly) for students in lunch bunch
- Lunch bunch option is offered for 12:45pm Twinkle-Toes classes.
- Students bring a lunch to eat with the teacher prior to class (12-12:45). WEAG preschool students will be picked up by the teacher and taken to the lunch area.

Dance Performance Fee:

All classes (except Twinkle-Toes) perform in the March 30th Production. A required \$40 per student fee, covers production expenses, including costume rental (except basic items — e.g., black tank leotard, black jazz pants, black leggings, tights, and shoes).

Multi-Class/Family Discount:

5% Discount for students taking two or more classes and/or two or more family members taking classes

Payment Options (3 options):

- 1) In full by 9/9
- 2) 50% on/before 9/9 & 1/6
- 3) 9 equal payments by 1st days of Oct.-April



REGISTRATION

Once registered, a student/student's parent(s) or guardian(s) are committed to pay, in full, for the entire class term, regardless of continued participation. Tuition is non-refundable. Credit will be given for doctor certified prolonged injury or illness only.

- You may choose one of three payment options:
 - In full on or before 9/9
 - 50% on or before 9/9 and 50% on or before 1/6/2025; or
 - 9 equal payments on or before the 1st day of each month Oct. April

ENSEMBLE:

- Ensemble offers training and ministry-focused performance opportunities for students committing to a certain level of training.
- Ensemble Classes are tuition-free; however, a \$25 yearly activities fee is due with registration for each of these classes, and the recital fee also applies.
- Ensemble is open, without audition, to intermediate/advanced students taking at least 1.75 paid weekly hrs. of other dance training in the Academy.



DRESS CODE

BALLET AND PRE-BALLET (TWINKLE TOES)

- tights (pink preferred)
- pink ballet slippers
- leotard (modern style, black preferred)
- hair in a bun, if possible

JAZZ, TAP, HIP HOP, MUSICAL THEATRE, AND BARRE

- any color leotard or fitted (modest) top
- tights, leggings, jazz pants or yoga pants
- black jazz oxfords for jazz
- jazz shoes, dance flats, or character shoes for Musical Theatre
- black, low-heel tap shoes for tap
- dance sneakers/sturdy tennis shoes/aerobic shoes for hip hop

MODERN, EXPRESSIVE, IMPROVISATION

- any color leotard or fitted (modest) top
- tights, leggings, jazz pants or yoga pants
- Bare feet

BOYS/MEN

- t-shirt, loose fitting pants or shorts
- appropriate footwear



POLICY

CLASS PLACEMENT: QUALITY AND LEVELS:

Faculty, teachers and students alike will be held to the standard of seeking excellence for Christ. Proper placement of students into the appropriate class levels is important in assuring quality training. Class placement, based on age, previous training and development, is made at the discretion of the teacher and ENCOR Director.

ATTENDANCE AND TARDINESS:

Please notify the instructor of any absence, illness or injury. Classes will start and conclude promptly. Students arriving late may be required to observe only — as dancing without adequate warm up may lead to injury. Students should make every effort to attend class regularly. Success and progress are inexorably tied to student commitment and practice — of which class attendance is of primary importance. No make-ups are given for absences. Lessons canceled due to conditions beyond ENCOR's control (e.g. medical mandates or closures, weather conditions) will be held in virtual format when possible. Cancellation updates will be sent to students/parents by email, voicemail, or text. ENCOR will occasionally hold classes on Richmond, Henrico and Chesterfield teacher workdays/school holidays that fall on Mondays. Please check the week-by-week schedule to ensure you have class dates in your calendar!

CLASS OBSERVATION:

Class observation will be permitted only on visitation days and/or by prior permission of the instructor.



HEALTH PROTOCOL
